a warm, natural element to their surroundings. Asian Loft's Indonesian lighting and artwork, crafted from leonia vines, add a touch of organic elegance to any space. The showroom also features a vibrant collection of hand-blown glass work in a variety of colors, shapes and functions direct from a glass-crafting village in China.
