Furniture designer, Michael Rozell, thought he would only make his mark in the design world with his creations in glass after being an apprentice for world famous glassblower Robert Eickholt. But, after more than a decade of success as a professional glassblower, a serious accident changed his trajectory, and he was forced to abruptly pivot.

One night while recovering from the accident, Michael's young son inspired him to create a simple stool, so that he could sit more easily to spend time playing with him. Overnight, an undiscovered passion and talent for furniture design was found, and Wooden Objex was born. His shift from glass to wood design showcases his resilience and innovative spirit, a testament to his commitment to creativity and craftsmanship.

Michael combines traditional woodcraft techniques with a modern mindset, transforming domestic and exotic woods into unique decorative pieces of sculpture, functional art and furniture.

Each one-of-a-kind piece is made by hand in his Granville, Ohio studio with careful care and selection of the wood. Each handmade piece reflects his meticulous attention to detail and reverence for the natural beauty of wood, elevating even the most functional pieces into works of art.
