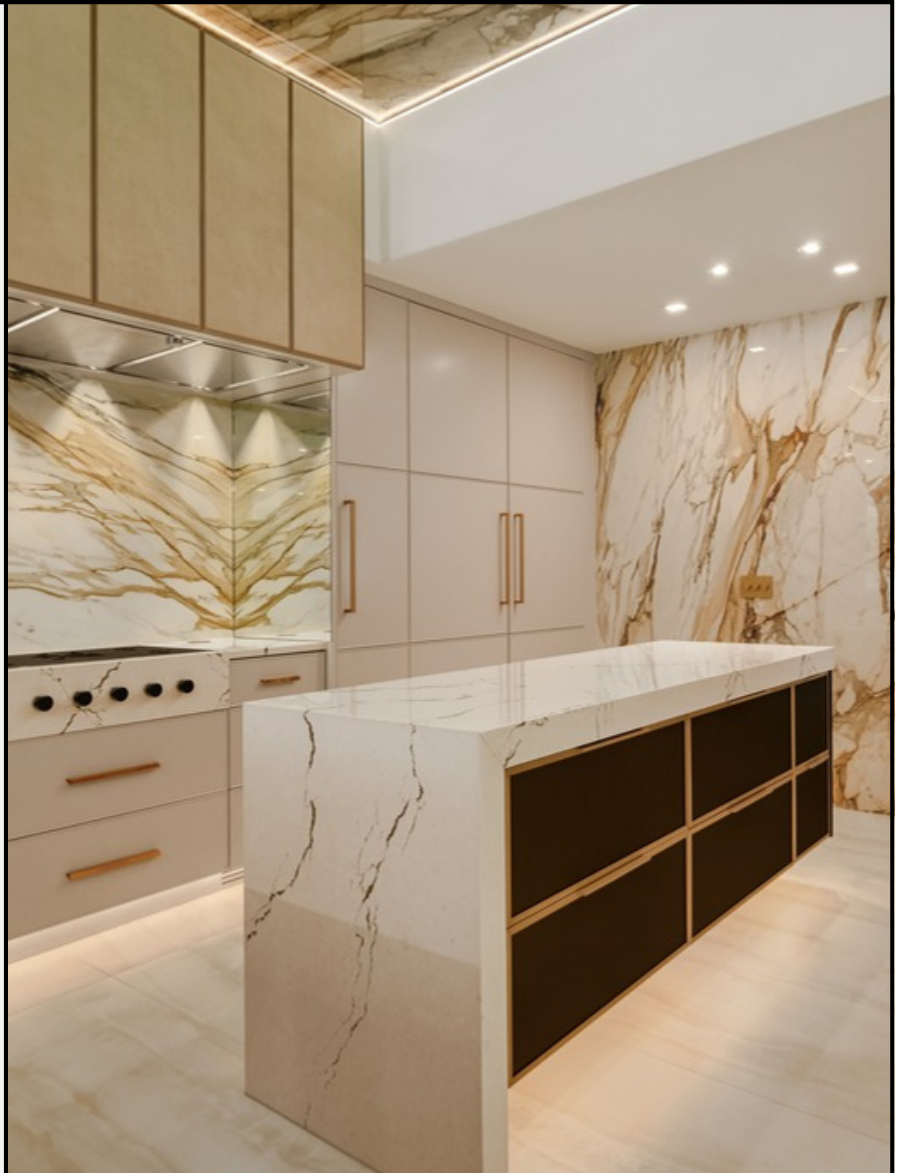

From a Fallen Oak Tree to a 75,000-Square-Foot Facility

Walker Woodworking began with founder Travis Walker's passion for woodworking. In the 1990s, while working as a paramedic, Travis used a fallen red oak planted by his grandfather to build a crib for his daughter and a china hutch, pieces his family still treasures today.

In 1996, he borrowed \$3,000 from his grandmother to purchase tools and pursue his craft. What began in a garage grew into Walker Woodworking, officially incorporated in 2001.

Today, Walker Woodworking operates from a 75,000-square-foot manufacturing facility in Shelby, North Carolina. Despite its growth, the company remains rooted in the same principles that started it all: exceptional craftsmanship, quality materials, investment in people and technology, and custom cabinetry made for the way people live.

The company combines advanced machinery with hands-on oversight, inspection and finishing to produce one-of-a-kind cabinetry. Each project moves through a team of engineers, artisans and craftspeople before installation.

THOUGHTFUL MATERIAL SELECTION

We proudly use domestic plywood from Columbia Forest Products, whose PureBond® technology eliminates formaldehyde and promotes healthier indoor air quality. Sourcing from a supplier near our manufacturing facility helps us reduce transportation emissions while supporting American-made materials. We also select hardwoods and veneers from regional suppliers who follow responsible forestry practices, ensuring our resources are renewable for generations to come.

Columbia Forest Products has several domestic milling locations; the one closest to our facility is in Old Fort, North Carolina.

We also source hardware from Blum, a leading manufacturer of cabinet hardware and accessories with a facility in nearby Stanley, North Carolina. Their commitment to precision engineering, long product life, and environmentally conscious manufacturing aligns perfectly with our own values.

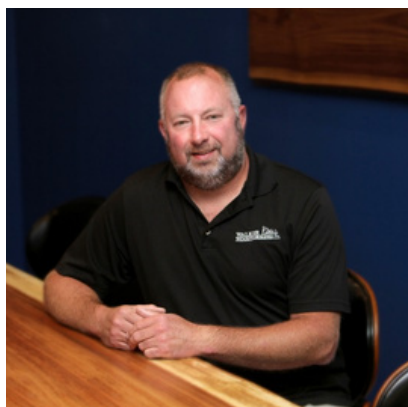
